Jesus said "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11 : 28)

The Person who gives you this invitation is the greatest and best Friend that you could ever have. He is the Lord Jesus Christ, the eternal Son of God. He is the one and only Mediator between God and men. He loved the world so much that He paid our enormous debt to God, by dying for us on the cross of Calvary.

He is the One who is almighty. He is God the Son. He has all power in heaven and earth - He has the keys of death and hell - He is now the appointed Mediator between God and man - He will one day be the Judge and King of all the earth. When One such as this speaks, you may safely trust Him.

Because of His love for you He invites you to COME TO HIM, and He will give you rest. If you feel the heavy load of the guilt of your sins, Jesus says to you, "COME UNTO ME."

Notice that He does not tell you to work for salvation. He does not tell you that you have to pay for salvation. He does not tell you to go to any other person for salvation. His invitation to you is, "COME UNTO ME." He further promises, "him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out." (John 6 : 37)

The Place Called Calvary

"And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." (Luke 23 : 33, 34) And one of the malefactors said unto Jesus, "Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise." (Luke 23 : 42, 43)

Gathered around the cross of Calvary, at that moment, stood Mary the mother of Jesus, John the beloved disciple, Mary Magdalene, and others. The dying thief did not pray to any of these people. He prayed directly to Jesus, the one and only Mediator between God and man. He came to Jesus, and Jesus gave him rest, and all the blessings of salvation.

A true Christian is a person who has come into a living relationship with the Lord Jesus as their personal Saviour. He lives a life of faith and trust in Jesus, confiding in Jesus, leaning on Jesus, speaking to Jesus in prayer, working for

Jesus, loving Jesus, and looking for the coming again of Jesus. St. Paul said, "the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God," (Galatians 2 : 20) Where there is true faith and trust, Jesus will be known as an actual living personal Friend.

The Rest Jesus Gives

The rest that Christ gives is an inward and spiritual thing. It is a rest of heart, rest of conscience, rest of mind, rest of will. It is rest, because your sins have all been forgiven and your guilt put away. This is the rest which the Lord Jesus gives to those who come to Him, by showing them His own finished work on the cross, by clothing them in His own perfect righteousness, and washing them in His own precious blood. When a man begins to see that the Son of God actually died for his sins, his soul begins to taste something of an inner peace.

There is only one way to find eternal rest for your soul. Let that never be forgotten. There is only one way to the Father - Jesus Christ; one door into heaven - Jesus Christ; and one path to peace in your heart - Jesus Christ.

Perhaps you are reading this leaflet and desire to be saved from your sin by Christ but have not yet taken this step. Come, I urge you: come to Christ now. Though you have been an awful sinner, COME - though you have long resisted
